By Coach

Outward Trains

Kirkham & Wesham station is the nearest station for fans of the club. However, there is only a limited service from that station. Therefore, we have also shown journeys from Preston Station.

The best station to travel to the Wembley area is Wembley Central Station. However, there are no direct services from the North West to Wembley Central Station. In addition the trains between Watford Junction and Wembley Central have limited capacity.

The train times to Wembley Central (allow 15 minutes walk to Wembley Stadium) with the relevant changes are as follows:

* Note the local London Overground trains between Watford Junction and Wembley Central have limited capacity.

If travelling via London Euston the best station to travel to for Wembley Stadium is Wembley Park Underground Station. This can be reached by walking from London Euston to Euston Square Underground Station and to travel on a Metropolitan Line train to Wembley Park Station (allow 40 minutes to reach Wembley Stadium from London Euston).

Park and Ride

For those travelling by car to the Match it is suggested that they park their cars at one of the following stations. For those with SatNav, the postcodes are also shown:

- Warwick Parkway CV35 8RH
- Banbury OX16 8AB
- Bicester North OX26 6EF
- High Wycombe HP13 6NN
- Beaconsfield HP9 2PJ

From the above stations there are frequent direct trains to Wembley Stadium Station but the times are not available at the time of writing. It is suggested that you allow up to 70 minutes to reach Wembley Stadium from each of the above stations.
